Add lettering to a design to create a stitched version of your favorite meme!


Materials

- Dino2018.BE embroidery from Embrilliance Project blog
- Embrilliance Essentials
- 40 wt embroidery thread
- Appropriate stabilizer & fabric for your project


Instructions

1. Download the Dino2018.zip file from the Embrilliance Project blog and unzip it to obtain this PDF file and the BE embroidery design.
2. Open the Dino2018.BE file in your Embrilliance Essentials software. File > Open
3. The object pane is made up of multiple “designs”. This is because you have opened the BE working file. The working file contains all designs that are opened/merged as well as any lettering objects that have been created.

The lettering objects in a working file allow you to access the properties pane when you select the particular lettering object. You can adjust any of the available properties for that object including spelling, Font used and spacing.



- Multiple lettering objects were created so that each could be sized and moved around individually. For example, the lettering object that says “COINCIDENCE?” if you want this word to be a different color for emphasis, you could select this object and change the color by clicking on the color chip.




- This will now add a new color change in the middle of the lettering, To eliminate this extra thread change, you can reorder objects in the object pane by RIGHT clicking on them. This will reveal a popup menu where you can choose where you want this to move in the list.

Earlier/Later will move this object up or down one spot.

Move First says that you want this to be the first item that stitches.

Move Last puts this object at the very end of the design.



- Have fun changing fonts, colors and moving the lettering objects around. There are many things that you can do with lettering in Embrilliance Essentials.
