



## Snowman with Fringed Scarf

This snowman design was digitized in StitchArtist using artwork from [clipartopolis.com](http://clipartopolis.com). Using the art as a guide, the fringe on the scarf ends lend a bit of movement to the embroidery design

### Design Color break Info

1. Knitted scarf
2. Snowman head
3. Snowman outline & facial details
4. Mittens
5. Mitten shading and outline
6. Carrot nose
7. Scarf Fringe

### Stitching Notes

1. Open the Snowman 2019 LShaw.BE file into your Embrilliance Essentials software.
2. Print an actual size template (**File > Print**) and save the stitch file to your machine format (**File > Save Stitch File**)
3. Stitch the design using thread colors of your choice - above is a list of what each color break will stitch to help you choose.
4. Colors #4 & #5 are for the mittens - the shading color could be a darker or contrasting shade.
5. After you stitch color #6, the nose, slide a small piece of tearaway stabilizer under your hoop where the fringe will stitch and then stitch color #7.
6. Remove hoop from the machine and turn it over to trim the bobbin threads. The stabilizer isolates the last color bobbin stitches so that you can easily trim them and fluff the fringe to the front. Yes, you can remove all of the excess tearaway after trimming the bobbin thread.
