

Acanthus Shamrock

This is textured design created in StitchArtist using layered objects and various underlay settings to create the rich depth of this design.

Design Information

- There are two color breaks in this design so that it can be stitched in either one or two colors.
- Color #1 is the diamond background and is a single run lace setting. *Design Idea: Lay a piece of organza or silk before stitching and trim before the second color to create a textured applique with contrasting background.*
- Because of the amount of underlay to hold the stitches, you will want to stitch this on a sturdy fabric AND/OR use proper stabilizer to hold the stitches without impacting the fabric.
- Color #2 is all of the decorative satin columns. There are no jump stitches. The layered objects were broken into smaller ones to accomplish both the visual layers as well as the structural base.
- For those learning to digitize, you should take note that there are 174 objects in this one color break. This is the best way to accomplish the style of the design. The number of objects has no impact on how the design stitches out - meaning there is ZERO NEED to “combine or group” objects so that there are less listed. In order to accomplish this luscious rich stitching design that stitches evenly and smoothly at the machine, you must have a significant number of objects.
